The South Ohio Community Centre has been able to replace its aging roof shingles, thanks to funding from two levels of government.

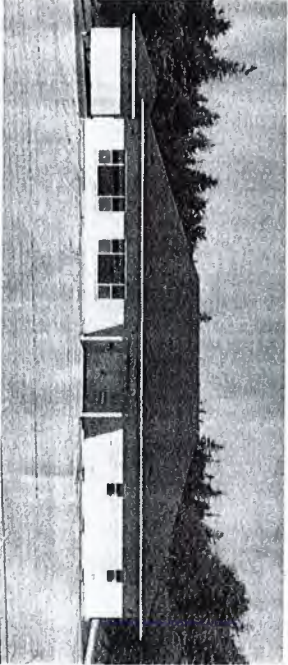
The majority of the funding came from the Government of Canada's New Horizons for Seniors Program, with a smaller amount received from the Municipality of the District of Yarmouth's grant program.

The South Ohio Community Centre has been in operation since 2004, offering programs and facilities for the South Ohio area and other neighboring communities. Crib nights, a kitchen party and seniors lunch and learn are among its popular ongoing programs.

The roof shingling was carried out by Rhyno's Roofing, a local contractor.

Scott Lutz, Community Centre president, said, "The funding we have received from the New Horizons for Seniors Program and the Municipality of the District of Yarmouth has made it possible for us to continue our programming in a safe and pleasant environment and we are grateful."

The New Horizons for Seniors Program is a federal grants and contributions program whose goal is to support projects that help improve the well-being of seniors and foster social inclusion and engagement in their communities.
