Dear Municipal Council,

It has been brought to the attention of the Memorial Club Monuments Committee that as a result of the Service Exchange Agreement between Municipalities and the Provincial Government, ownership of municipal schools will be transferring to the Province. We would like to ensure Council is aware the War Memorial Monuments are sitting on the lands which the Municipality will be signing over. Our committee has overseen the upkeep of the monuments, and surrounding area, for many years since they were erected.

The Memorial Club Monument Committee is asking if Council would consider a perpetual lease or an easement of access to the Monuments for future maintenance ensuring on-going access to the monuments. This will help ensure the monuments to not become neglected. The Committee has always had a verbal agreement with the Tri County Regional School Board regarding access, however the results of the Service Exchange present a risk prompting the Committee to legally secure its interest.

Please accept this letter as a formal request for consideration which is greatly appreciated. The Committee would also be interested in making a presentation to the Municipal Council.
